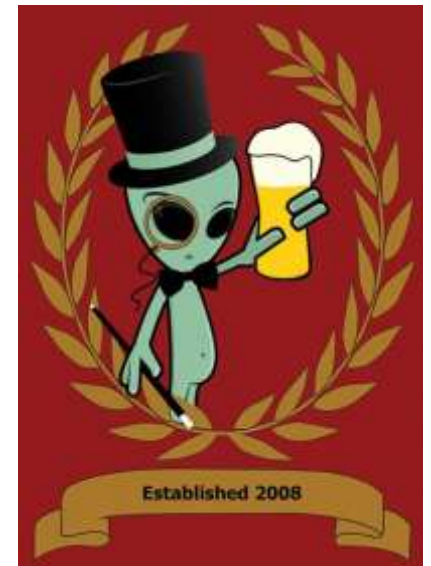

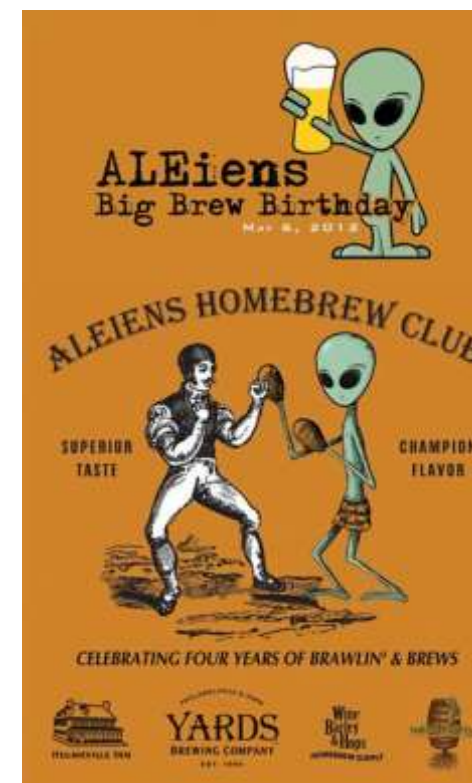

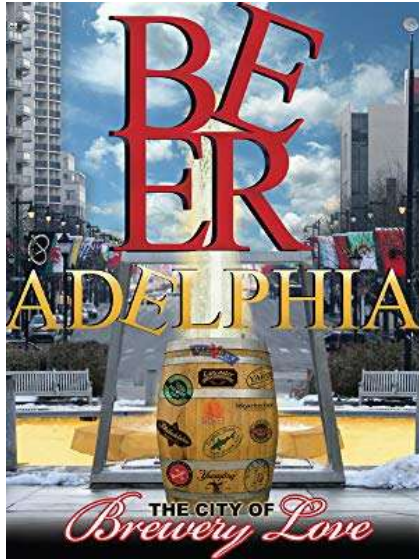

 - If equipment is broken, the member is expected to provide payment to return to working order.

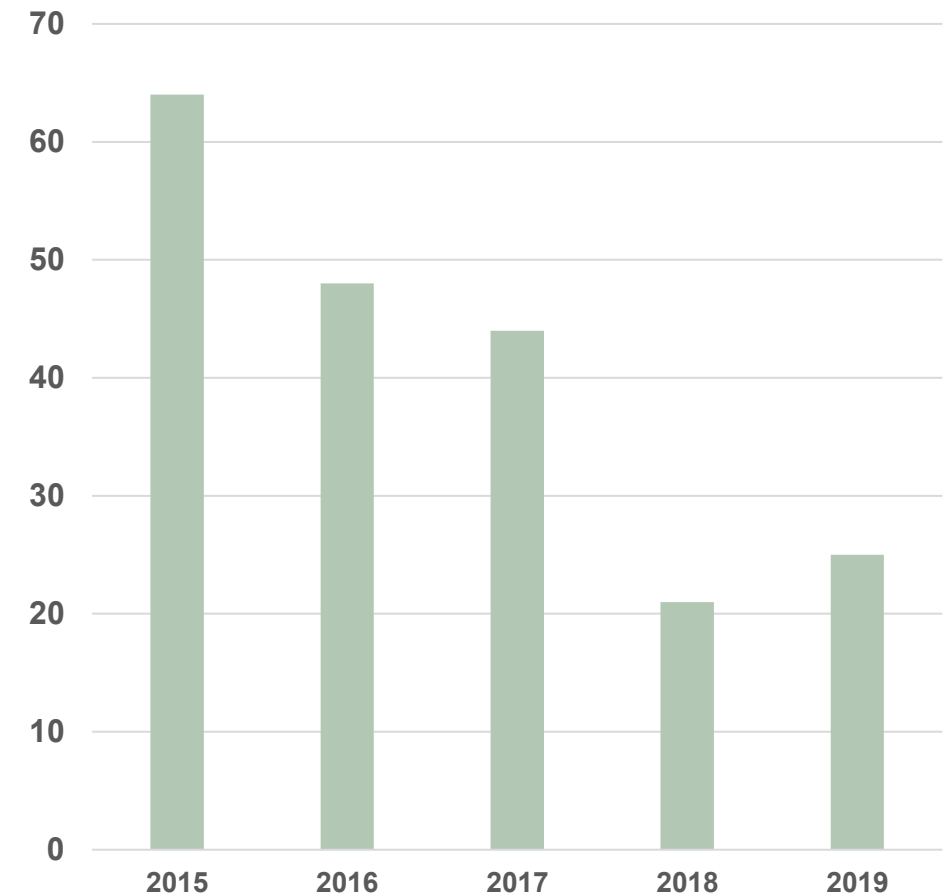
